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Financial ratios are often calculated by using amounts from previously issued annual financial statements. Financial ratios relate or connect two amounts from a company's financial statements (balance sheet, income statement, statement of cash flows, etc.). That along with vertical analysis and horizontal analysis (all of which we discuss) are part of what is known as financial statement analysis. $\text{Future Value} / \text{Total amount accrued} = \text{Payment} / \text{Deposit made in each period} = \text{rate per period (usually)} = \text{total number of times compounded}$. Financial ratios are one component of financial analysis. Formula Interpretation The ROA formula is an important ratio in analyzing a company's profitability. The ratio is typically used when comparing a company's performance between periods, or when comparing two different companies of similar size and industry. $\text{Future Value} / \text{Total amount accrued} = \text{Payment} / \text{Deposit made in each period} = \text{rate per period (usually)} = \text{total number of times compounded}$. The payment/deposit is at the END of the period. The use of financial ratios is also referred to as financial ratio analysis or ratio analysis.
