From the dropdown menu, choose Encrypt with Password. Select the file or drag it onto the screen, create a password, and then click the Protect PDF files button Open the document you would like to password-protect. Select Info. When prompted, select Yes. In the Certificate Security Settings dialog, select the document components to encrypt.
