On Windows, just right-click your PDF and select Properties > Read-only > OK. On a Mac computer, the process is a little more complex. Select the PDF and click File > Get Info. Once your document is open, go to the "File" section of your taskbar, pull down the "Protect" menu, and choose the Encrypt with Password option Here's how you make a PDF read-only online using Sejda: Go to the Sejda site and press "Upload PDF files". Click Open. Once you have installed PDFelement, right-click on your PDF document, display the "Open With" menu, and select PDFelement.
