Click where you want the image. · Press Command + C to copy the selected pixels to your Mac's clipboard, and then press Command + V to paste them back into the same image. The image will be placed into the document. Adjust your image. If you need to move the image from the initial placement, click and drag it to another position. Step: Download and launch the UPDF app on your Mac. After opening UPDF, click the "Open File" button that appears on the main interface of the app. This button launches an explorer window from which you can select the PDF file into which you wish to add an image. Press ⌘+C to copy the new object image to Click the image you want to input. Solution: How to Add Images into PDF Mac Using Preview. Yes, paste the Solution: How to Add Image to PDF on Mac Using Adobe Acrobat. It's not as simple as copying/pasting the image out of preview first. On your Mac, click the Finder icon in the Dock to open a Finder window. Press the following key sequences: ⌘+A (select the entire image) ⌘+C (copy it to the clipboard) ⌘+V (paste the image on top of the original as an "object image") Click on the object image you just pasted on top of the original image.
