

Motivation (1) In low and middle-income countries (LMICs), agricultural development strategies put a great emphasis on small farms. significantly increase smallholder yields
Definition
Smallholders are those with a low asset base operating less than a ha of cropland (World Bank)
Smallholder farms are defined as those farms operating a ha or less (UNCTAD)
In the United States, farm size is defined by an economic criterion: the “gross product.”
Providing these factors can help people. A subset of these farms, labeled small producers or “smallholders”, are at the center of many food systems (FAO, n.d.). The purpose is to enable more productive interactions between smallholders, food security, and the environment. The standard, which has a flexible smallholder definition, is designed for farmers with less than a ha of land and revolves around four main compliance requirements for groups and members)
