

When I print to a PDF, it used to be that the file name autofilled (so I didn't need to type it) and the folder location was the last In the Print dialog (when printing a PDF) you can add a header with \$D for directory and \$F for filename to print the directory and filename automatically. Delete source files after the combining operation. Is there a way to add the file name automatically when printing so i don't have to type it in to every document? Open Devices and Printers on · Create a PDF using the Print command (Windows) Open the file in its authoring application, and choose File > Print. Otherwise, choose Acrobat Default. If a custom printer settings file exists with the settings you want, choose it from the Settings menu. These options will apply to subsequent prints of new files until removed by the user I have a large number of individual acrobat files to print and I need the file name to print on every document. I often print the same file to PDF and do not want it to overwrite so I can see gradual changes to a document without having to rename the file manually each time.
