The BSS is a paper-and-pencil test designed to measure satisfaction/dissatisfaction with body parts (half involving the head and the other half involving the body), and it takes 15 minutes to complete. The SSI scale was found to have high internal consistency and moderately high correlations with clinical ratings of suicidal risk and self-administered measures of self-harm. The first five items of the BSS serve as a screening device for suicidal ideation during the last week (including the day of assessment) and are summed up to the BSS-Screen score.
