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Scan from proximal metacarpals through distal radial/ulnar metaphysis. When scanning the HAND From just proximal to the distal radioulnar joint to include the entire hand. Collimation Hand is positioned pronated with fingers straight and close together (unlike in this picture) CT imaging increasingly relies on the integration of a variety of knowledge and skills. Hand: Patient Position: Patient lying in prone position, with affected arm extended above head. The first three sections of this text provide information on physics, patient care, and cross-sectional anatomy necessary to understand and carry out CT examination protocols. To avoid streak artifact through the torso please place patient's arms on a pillow. Coronal Imaging Plane Routine Wrist/Hand CT Positioning Patient prone Arm straight above head, palm down ("Mighty Mouse" position) Coverage When scanning the WRIST From the distal radial diaphysis to the third metacarpal base. Place body off centered in effort to set affected hand in isocenter.
