You need to know the stem of the verb to be able to conjugate the verb. The stem is the part of the verb without the infinitive ending. The strong or irregular verbs are not as difficult to learn as The German language differentiates between two types of verbs: weak and strong. Die Erde bewegt sich um die Sonne (The Earth moves/revolves around the sun)When used in the meaning “to frighten someone”, it’s a weak verb: Ich erschreckte ihn (I frightened him)essen is for eating done by humans, not by animals. Strong verbs have a vowel gradation (examples are sing, sang and sung). See fressen Weak Verbs in the Perfect Tense. Weak verbs have a dental consonant (the tongue is pressed against the upper teeth) that is inflected and changed.
