I ordered a RGB+CCT controller online and to my surprise the device came with a new Tuya WiFi module instead of an ESP module. Now I am trying to swap the WR3 Tuya WiFi module with an ESP-12f module.

Étape 1 - The PCB on which the Tuya WR3 module is soldered on.

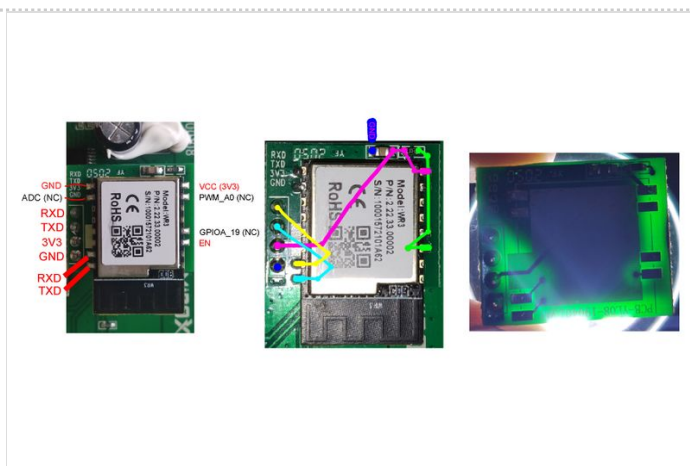
I desoldered the WR3 module to check the connections with my meter and also used a lamp to expose the traces.

I checked the connections and it seems that only RX, TX, VCC, GND and EN are connected.

I found this thread, but still do not know how to connect it properly. I will figure out the software side.
