In one sense, Jaspers' philosophy has a deontological and open aspect true of the philosophy of Karl Jaspers. From his youth on he found academic orthodoxies incredible and irrelevant to the human situation. Philosophy is to be found in the questions asked by children. It is not uncommon to hear from the mouths of children words which penetrate to the very depths of philosophy. A few examples: out in wonderment, I keep trying to be somebody else, but I'm, always myself. "My boy has touched on one of the universal sources of intuition, awareness of being through abstraction.
