This Criterion C: Persistent effortful avoidance of distressing trauma-related stimuli (1 or more): Trauma-related thoughts/feelings Trauma-related external reminders Criterion D: Negative cognitions/mood (2 of 7) Inability to recall key features of the trauma Negative beliefs about oneself, the world Distorted blame of self, others A traumatic experience(s) is something that threatens a person's life, safety or the lives of people around them. After trauma exposes the victim to actual or threatened death or serious injury, dimensions of PTSD unfold: (1) reexperiencing the event with distressing recollections, PTSD is a disorder that some people develop after experiencing a shocking, scary, or dangerous event. It is natural to feel afraid during and after a traumatic situation.

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
