

Try Adobe Acrobat online for free Once your PDF is created, you can generate fields using the Forms wizard in Adobe Acrobat. This can be done on a Mac, but the simplest way to do it is to set your templates up using a Windows version. However, note that most likely you will have to accept all changes and then turn off Track Changes to get the desired appearance when printing to PDF (or printing to paper, for that matter) With the Word Options dialog box still open, do the following: Click Advanced at the left side of the Word Options dialog box. Scroll down until you see the Print section. However, I don't know if that feature is available in the free version, but it's worth checking outGo to File > Options > Display and uncheck the option Update fields before printing. (My experiment shows that this option also affects saving to PDF as well as printing to PDF.) If that doesn't work for you, you can select the whole document (Ctrl+A) and lock the fields (Ctrl+F11) to prevent them from updating The best way to do this is with mapped content controls, IMO.
